City of Salem Lakes John Hay & Salinda Rules & Regulations

The city hereby establishes the following rules and regulations on the premises of Lake Salinda and Lake John Hay:

- 1. No gasoline power boat shall be operated on the lakes.
- 2. No swimming or wading.
- 3. Properly licensed hand propelled boats or boats with electric trolling motors may be operated on the lakes.
- 4. No person shall possess, display or operate any firearms on the premises including the real estate owned by the Salem Water Works surrounding the lakes in question.
- 5. No livestock, dogs, cats or other pets may be possessed or transported on the premises.
- 6. No overnight camping shall be permitted on the premises.
- 7. No open fire shall be lit and maintained on the premises.
- 8. No waste or refuse shall be deposited or dumped into the lake or onto the premises surrounding the lakes.
- 9. No fishing shall be permitted within five hundred (500) feet of the intake structure of each lake.
- 10. No person engaging in fishing shall use trout lines or throw line or use carp or goldfish minnows as bait.
- 11. No person shall consume alcoholic beverages on the premises.
- 12. No person shall engage in any type of hunting on the premises.
- 13. No person shall enter the premises between the hours from sunset to sunrise.
- 14. Ice fishing is allowed on Lake Salinda ONLY.
- 15. All boats used on either lake shall be properly licensed pursuant to Salem Municipal Code, Section 36-10-2-3(b) and shall be stored or harbored only in designated docking or storage areas.
- 16. No operating of any motor vehicles on the premises other than on public access roadways, parking lots, boat launching ramps or designated picnic areas.
- 17. All fishing rules and regulations of the State of Indiana apply as to the possession of fishing a license, size of fish and number of fish caught per day.
